# Mark Your Calendar

**Garbage Collection:** *Each Monday and Thursday - Week of July 4th pick-ups will be Tuesday and Thursday - Do not place garbage outside of container until the morning of collection.*

**Recyclables:** *Friday July 8th & 22nd- Do not put out recyclables before 5:00pm the night before pick-up. Please put recyclables in containers, not plastic bags as it cannot be readily identified as garbage or recyclables. Only "button cell" and rechargeable batteries are recyclable. All other batteries go into regular garbage*

**Manchester Bulk Pick-up** *Thursday - July 7th Items must be out by 6:30am for pick-up. Manchester will not return once your house has been passed.*

**Village Light Bulk Pick-Up** *July 27th - Last Wed of every month. Includes all electronics  
NOTE: Bulk pick-up is for oversize items - NOT entire house clean-up. We will pick up special clean-ups - but only by special arrangement with the Maintenance Dept .*

**Yard Debris** *Every Thursday.. Remember leaves and pine needles ONLY!!! CANNOT be picked up in plastic bags... The refuse center will not let us dump plastic bags... It must be in bio-degradable paper bags ONLY!!! Available at maintenance dept or local stores..*

**Brush / Branches** *Every Thursday at the curb..*

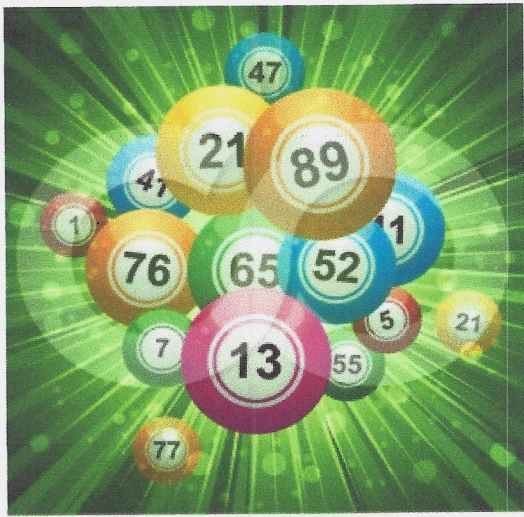

## ***Info from CARES!***

*Somebody Cares will be offering free blood pressure readings to local residents on the first Thursday of each month from 10:00am to 12:00 noon. Record pads will be available if one has to chart their blood pressure monthly for a medical purpose.*

*The next reading will be July 7th at the Cares building - 48 Schoolhouse Rd. This service will be provided by Holy Redeemer Medical Services of Toms River.*

### ***Bar-B-Q Grilles, Fire Pits, Chimneys***

*This is the time when you are making good use of your propane grille. Remember it must be no closer to the building than 10' when in use. It must not be used or stored under a covered patio. When not in use the propane tank should be turned off and no closer to the building than 5'. Be safe!! While we're on the subject of fires, remember fire pits and chimneys are not allowed in Village 1.*

### ***Feeding Wild Animals!***

*Feeding wild geese, cats etc. is a violation of the rules and regulations of this village as well as the laws of Manchester Township. Those rules in this village state you will be fined up to \$500.00 and unpaid or constant fines can lead to eviction. Please don't feed any wild animals. Wild animals carry diseases we do not need! Fines are being levied for doing so. See Rule # 32 of the rules and regulations.*

### ***Mailboxes***

*Police, Fire Dept. and First Aid have asked us to stress the importance of a name and number on every mailbox. It could mean a difference in response time in case of emergency. If you would like a plate with both, call the office. If nothing else, at least get some stick on numbers. That's better than nothing.*

### **Doing some work around the house?**

The State of New Jersey Uniform Construction Code Regulations is the rules that govern when and if permits are required. The following are some examples but should not be considered an all inclusive list.

#### **Permits are required if:**

- You cut away a wall or any portion thereof
- You cut any structural beam or bearing support
- Construct an addition or make alterations to your home i.e., enclosing a porch or patio cover
- Installing, replacing or re-locating a hot water heater
- Installing, replacing or re-locating any water drainage or venting
- Installation of heating or air conditioning systems
- Installation or upgrading any electrical wiring or plumbing

#### **Permits are not necessary, but permission from the Co-Op is if:**

- You add or replace shutters, awnings or railings
- Installation of Solar tubes
- Installation of Satellite Dish (TV)
- Window replacements
- Tree planting – location to be checked

**Residents are required to have their contractor provide a certificate of insurance to the Trustees office before any work is started. If you're having work done call the Maintenance Department and check if any of the above applies to your project.**

### **Bar-B-Q Grilles, Fire Pits, Chimneys**

*This is the time when you are making good use of your propane grille. Remember it must be no closer to the building than 10' when in use. It must not be used or stored under a covered patio. When not in use the propane tank should be turned off and no closer to the building than 5'. Be safe!! While we're on the subject of fires, remember fire pits and chimneys are not allowed in Village 1.*

### **On Street Parking...**

*Since changing the rules to allow on street parking, it seems to have alleviated many problems at Quads. But to make sure everyone clearly understands.... You must park in **YOUR ASSIGNED SPACE!!!** You cannot use a guest space. Guest spaces are for the use of all residents of the building --**BY THEIR GUESTS!!!***

*Remember when parking on street **DO NOT** block mailboxes, driveways, fire hydrants, too close to corners etc...*

#### **PARK LEGALLY!!!**

*Let your visitors know if no guest spaces are available at your address, they must park on the street or at clubhouse.*

# Trustees Notes.....

## Dates to remember...

Sept 19.....Annual Shareholders meeting

### Maintenance.....

Replacement of aluminum siding is ongoing as we are now through nearly 1/2 of Lilac Lane. This multi year project should be finished by August, This makes this village the first Co-Op to eliminate much maintenance on the exterior of our buildings.

Replacement of in ground concrete clad garbage receptacles. These will be replaced in order of severity of damage after the snow storm damage this past winter.

Gutter cleaning - we have now started cleaning gutters 4 times a year.

### Satellite Dish

If you're thinking of having a satellite dish installed on your home, you must:

- submit a request prior to installation to the Trustees office
- Advise Maint dept of date of installation
- Notify Maint when installer arrives
- We will give you printed installation instructions for the installer

**We inspect after installation and if it is installed incorrectly, you will need to have it corrected,**

When selling your home, the dish must be removed even if the new owner intends to have a dish installed, All dish services install a new dish upon installation of service and will not use a pre-existing unit and also will not remove a unit at end of service, That's your responsibility. This must be done prior to closing.

### NOTICE!!

If you have a request for parking permits for additional vehicles, changes or additions to your home such as a patio, tree planting etc., notify the Trustees office. If you want to order repairs, call the Maintenance department.

### Merchandise Pick Ups

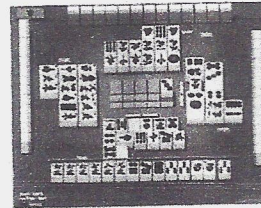

If you purchase the item ahead of time and bring the pick-up receipt to the maintenance office they can pick up your item the next time they go out for supplies **FREE of CHARGE... This service applies ONLY to the Lowes on Route 70 in Manchester.** This is a great bargain compared to paying the delivery charges from Lowes. Contact the maintenance department for more info.

As for the Board of Trustees, we welcome you and sincerely hope that a year from now you'll be telling your friends "this is the best move I've ever made".

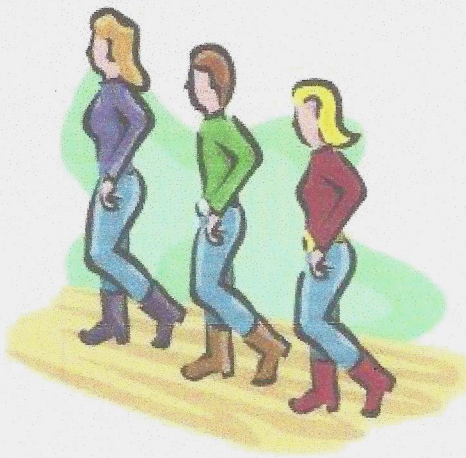
