#### Homes for Sale in Village One

Currently there are 15 homes listed for sale in Village One on the Multiple Listings website. They range in price from \$28,000 to \$99,900.

#### Feeding Wild Animals... Copy of Rule #31states:

31. The feeding of any wild animal (including feral cats) and or wild water fowl (includ-

ing Canadian Geese) is strictly forbidden. As empowered under Article V, Section 4J of the Bylaws, Trustees will assess a fine of \$50.00 for the first violation of rules 29, 30 and 31 and up to \$500.00 for succeeding violations.

#### Bar-B-Q Grilles, Fire Pits, Chimneys

This is the time when you are making good use of your propane grille. Remember it must be no closer to the building than 10' when in use. It must not be used or stored under a covered patio. When not in use the propane tank should be turned off and no closer to the building than 5'. Be safe!! While we're on the subject of fires, remember fire pits and chimneys are not allowed in Village One.

### **Ocean County Library**

#### **Welcomes Patrons Back July 6**



As you may be aware, the Governor recently permitted libraries the ability to reopen at 25% capacity beginning July 2nd. We have developed a phased reopening plan to provide service in the safest way possible. As we prepare to welcome you back, here is what you can expect:

**Returns:** We will open book drops at all OCL locations beginning Monday, June 29th. All materials returned will be quarantined for the recommended length of time set by public health officials, after which they will be checked in and added back to our collection. Overdue fines will not accrue on materials during this time.

**Hours of Operation:** Beginning Monday, July 6th we will open our doors with limited hours and services.

#### Whiting branch will be open:

Monday 10am – 2pm, and 3pm – 7pm Tuesday through Saturday 10am – 2pm

**Pick-up of Materials:** Beginning on Monday, July 6th contactless pickup of materials will be available, using our self-pick up holds and our self-check kiosks. Please remember to bring your library card to use the kiosks. Additionally, short-term browsing will be allowed; we ask that you are mindful of those wishing to use the library and limit your time spent in our libraries due to the limited 25% capacity.

**Access to Computers:** We will provide access to public PCs by appointment. Due to the limited number of PCs available to provide social distancing, computer use will be reduced to one half hour per day. We encourage you to take advantage of our mobile printing service so your library visit is as streamlined as possible.

**Public Spaces:** Seating will be limited to allow for social distancing. At this time, our meeting rooms and quiet study areas will be utilized for the quarantining of materials. All in-person programs and events are suspended. All customers will be required to wear face masks and to adhere to social distancing guidelines.

#### **RECYCLING...**

All recycling must be placed in a container curbside, should it be out in any type of plastic bag it will not be picked up until the owner places the recycling in a container.

#### Doing some work around the house...

**PERMITS** 

The State of New Jersey Uniform Construction Code Regulations is the rules that govern when and if permits are required. The following are some examples but should not be considered an all inclusive list.

#### Permits are required if:

- You cut away a wall or any portion thereof
- You cut any structural beam or bearing support
- Construct an addition or make alterations to your home
   i.e. enclosing a porch or patio cover
- Installing, replacing or re-locating a hot water heater
- Installing, replacing or re-locating any water drainage or venting
- Installing of heating or air conditioning systems
- Installation or upgrading any electrical wiring or plumbing

#### Permits are not necessary, but permission from the Co-op is if:

- You add or replace shutters, awnings or railings
- Installation of Solar tubes
- Installation of Satellite Dish (TV)
- Window replacements
- Residents are required to have their contractor provide a certificate of insurance to the Trustees office before any work is started. If you're having work done call the Maintenance Department and check if any of the above applies to your project.

#### Dear Resident,

The Township of Manchester has contracted with VEPO Metering to perform an upgrade of the water meter reading system. This upgrade is expected to begin in your area within the next few weeks. This is a mandatory upgrade program. You will not need to be home for this work to be performed – your water meter is most likely located in a crawl space accessible from the outside of the home. The process is expected to take no more than one hour, and the water will be disrupted for 15-20 minutes. If the technician is unsuccessful in performing the work, they will leave a notification on your door to contact them to schedule an appointment.

As a courtesy, residents providing VEPO Metering with an email address and / or contact number will receive an electronic notification with a photo of the technician prior to the visit. The technician will not require access to the inside of your home, although they may ring your doorbell or knock on your door to inform you of their presence. All VEPO technicians will be in uniform with a photo ID with identifiable vehicle signs.

The Township appreciates your support and cooperation with this very important project. This project will provide the Township and you with a significantly improved metering system that will greatly increase meter accuracy, monitor leaks, reduce the need for estimated billing and provide a savings to the you and the Township.

Lastly, for the safety of our residents and the VEPO Metering technicians, we ask that you limit the interactions between you and the VEPO Metering technicians as much as possible, always making sure to maintain a six-foot social distance. The technician will be wearing a face covering and gloves anytime interaction with the resident is possible.

We look forward to working with you to complete this mandatory project and thank you for your support in advance.

# Silhouettes

A great way to add impact to your photos is using silhouettes. They are caused when a bright light source is behind your subject, leaving your subject in the shadows. Silhouettes can occur at any time of day. Sunrise and set, bright beaches, and twilight shots all make good silhouette opportunities.

Make certain your background is exposed properly. Since the background will be brighter than the subject, your subject will be underexposed, making your silhouette. Twilight and night silhouettes will have long exposures, so you'll probably need a tripod.
