### **Holiday Greetings from the Village 1 Maintenance Department!**

Total Work Orders (past 30 days) = 260

I apologize if I sound like a broken record, but this month I will go over the snow removal procedures for Village 1 once more. This is a very important topic that everyone needs to be aware of. If you ever need clarification or have any questions regarding the snow removal procedure please contact the Maintenance Department or the Trustees Office. On days of snow removal, the phones at the Maintenance Department will not be answered directly. Please leave a message and someone will return your call at our earliest availability. Snow stakes have been installed, please do not remove or move these stakes as they are positioned to help the plow drivers navigate around potential hazards.

Please see below for Crestwood Village 1's snow clearing guidelines. The information provided below comes directly from the Board of Trustees. The biggest thing we can request is that all residents stay inside when the street and driveway clearing is underway and to please exercise patience and understanding during these times. Special consideration for priority snow removal will only be arranged for medical appointments and outpatient treatments. You are required to provide the Trustee's Office a copy of your doctor's name, phone number and time of your appointment on your respective doctor's letterhead. This must be provided in advance, we will not be able to accommodate calls made the morning of a snow storm. After verifying the information provided, the Board of Trustees and the Trustees Office will prioritize the clearing of these units. The Board of Trustees will not make special arrangements for those that are employed, it will not entitle you to priority snow removal. Please do not call the Maintenance Department to request individual attention, the only ones that can authorize priority snow plowing are the Trustees.

- Roads will not be plowed until there is around 3" of snow accumulation;
- When icy conditions are present, ice melt will be applied to the roads;
- **NO** on-street parking is allowed for impending snow, you will be assessed a \$50 fine and parking on the grass is not acceptable. If you do leave your vehicle on the grass or road during plowing activities, you will be plowed in. If you require assistance to get your vehicle out, you will be charged a minimum of \$60 for the service and will not be addressed until all other snow clearing activities are completed;
- Residents are not to push, shovel, blow or deposit snow onto Village roadways;
- When the roads are made passable, the Maintenance Department will begin to clear driveways, then followed by sidewalks;
- Duplex driveways will be cleared and treated as sidewalks, as you do have secondary means to exit and enter the building through your garage door;
- Quad driveways will be cleared by pushing the snow forward towards the buildings or to the side when available, depending
  on the positioning of your building;
- Sidewalks will be cleared as soon as possible, depending on the man-power that is available and after roads and driveways are cleared;
- Keep a bag or two of ice melt on hand for your steps and sidewalk area (available through the Maintenance Department, call
  for pricing and for delivery). The snow melt provided by the Maintenance Department is not advertised as animal friendly;
- THERE WILL BE NO DEVIATION FROM OUR SNOW REMOVAL PROGRAM.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation! Hope everyone stays warm and safe during these winter months ahead!

### THE MANCHESTER COORDINATING COUNCIL MEETING

The election was held for Mayor and Council positions. 3 teams were running, and 2 top people are running again. At least 50% of votes must be had by one candidate. Re-election will be held 12/13/22

Legislative chairwoman Judy Noonan gave an update. The case hearing regarding Berkeley Twp vs New Jersey Board of Realtors will be held Friday. If Berkeley loses, this case will be used as a reference for under age purchase of units. This issue has been going on since 2005. Under-age purchases in a 55-plus community are currently not allowed. Whiting and Manchester residents have done a wonderful job writing letters and signing petitions against the bills that are circulating. The Docket # for the NJ BOARD OF REALTORS VS BERKELEY case # is LDN-9910CN-L22.

Karen Argenti spoke about our Pinelands. 75% of Manchester is in the Pinelands. The Clean water act was passed in 1972 to protect water quality. Watershed is like a big bathtub with hills and ridges; all the water that falls in the water shed falls down to the lowest point. Wetlands are important to our eco system that needs protection They allow the series of habitat to continue. Wherever the rain falls, it should absorb there or as close as possible. Rolling water on roadways and drives picks up dirt and grime. Impervious surface is paved streets, parking lots, and building rooftops. As much as 5% impervious surface next to a stream of an urban lake will impair the water body. Soaking the rain where it falls is important to our rivers and streams. Manchester twp should cover 2% of their impervious surface each year to give more protection to our water. Permeable pavement should be used in all parking lots so the rain can stay where it is. New buildings in the area are encouraged by the town to use permeable pavement. Grass doesn't have enough roots to carry the rainwater into the soil. This is why native plants are so important. The rain is carried straight down through the roots of the native plants.

Lavender is an example of a native plant in our area.

The building department looks at our demographics' average income for Manchester which is less than \$46,000. \$37,000 is more likely. Builders are more likely going to see the medium income and decide Brick etc are better options than Manchester.

In 2004 the courts informed Manchester they were to put up additional homes. Options were Heritage, behind Renaissance, and Route 571.

2 years ago Heritage started putting water pipes and fire hydrants in. They still have 2400 homes approved by the court. They want more than 2400. There's 543 acres available to build these homes. Warehouses would also be an option. Less traffic on the roads but lots of trucks.

A WAWA is being built at the first circle in Lakehurst.




