We expect to finish up the last of the driveway replacements in late Spring. One of the next big projects we will be scheduling is sealcoating the Village roads. This will be a several year project. We always like seeing a smiling face! The office opens at 9am and closes at 4pm. Rarely does our office close for lunch. This may happen only if something unexpected came up. We do also have a drop box next to our office door if that should happen.

Please be a responsible dog owner and remember to pick up after your dogs. It is not fair to leave it for someone else to clean. It only takes a second to pick up. If you are not physically able to bend over and pick it up, you can purchase a long handled dust pan to scoop it. We also ask to pull your dog away from the garbage cans. # KIRMS PHOTOGRAPHY Shore Birds

If you've been reading my articles each month you know my favorite subject is nature. Many animals are not as active in the cold months, and many birds leave the area and go south. There are other birds that migrate here from the northern reaches to escape the ultra harsh winters there. This gives us the opportunity to photograph different species. Unfortunately they are not as colorful in the winter plumage, but it's still a nice challenge to find them.

I especially like to find the different ducks and shore birds that arrive in winter. They are generally found in the inlets and around the jetties. Some are quite difficult to reach, but others can be found along roadways and parking lots near rivers.

A long lens is very helpful. Focus carefully and have the proper exposure. Fast shutter speeds will help keep them sharp if they are moving in the waves. It is not an easy shoot, but can yield great results.

Temperatures are finally dropping and with that, people are using their heaters more and more often. This is a topic that has been discussed in the past, but with the turnover of new people in the Village, I feel it needs to be brought up again. Especially with two separate issues recently that the Maintenance Department had to resolve.

This is not an issue that will affect everyone, but it is imperative that those with this specific model of thermostat have them replaced. These are older thermostats that have a tendency to burn up. Thankfully no fires have occurred due to these yet, but it does cause damage to sheetrock, insulation and your electric.


